Contest Deadline

◆ DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES IS **MAY 1, 2010**.

Entry Details

- ◆ Contest is for public, private and home school MD students in grades K-12. Creativity and color are encouraged in student's original artwork.
- ◆ Artwork entered in the contest should feature **Maryland Agriculture**. The calendar will highlight the diversity of agriculture throughout our state.
- ◆ MEDIA SHOULD BE MARKER, CRAYON, WATERCOLOR, INK, ACRYLIC, TEMPERA PAINT or COLORED PENCIL. No pastels, chalk, or pencil drawings will be accepted.
- ◆ Entries must be 8.5 by 11 inches and **HORIZONTAL (landscape)** orientation (NOT vertical).
- ◆ Entries must be on paper that will allow for duplication, scanning and display. Entries must be flat, **NOT** folded, matted, mounted, laminated or framed. The use of cartoon characters or TV figures is not acceptable.
- ◆ An official entry blank or copy **MUST** be completed and securely attached to the **back** of each entry. (Please duplicate as needed.) Make sure each entry form is filled out completely and that writing is legible.
- ◆ **Entries should be mailed to:** Maryland Agricultural Education Foundation, P.O. Box 536, Havre de Grace, MD 21078.
- ◆ All entries will become the property of the Maryland Agricultural Education Foundation and will not be returned. Maryland Agricultural Education Foundation reserves the right to publish the entries in future publications and promotions without additional compensation.

- ◆ Students will receive a \$50 cash award and their art work will be featured in the 2010-2011 Maryland Agricultural Education Foundation, Inc. Calendar and posted on MAEF's website.
