Take the Capital Beltway to John Hanson Highway/Route 50 East to Chesapeake Bay Bridge. Cross Chesapeake Bay Bridge. Continue on Route 50 East after the 50/301 split. Look for sign , turn right on Carmichael Road. Pintail Point is located 1.5 miles on the right.
